#### SUZANNE RAMADAN DISCOVERS NEW MIRACLE OF QUR'AN FEATURES


Ibsan, AKA Suzanne Mamodesene, discovered that the basic pillars of Islam—worshiping God alone, Salat, fasting, Zakat, & Hajj occur in suras & verses whose numbers add up to multiples of <u>19</u>:


Like the Old Testament and the New Testament, the Koran's First Commandment is to worship God ALONE. This crucial word, in Arabic "Wahdahu" occurs in four chapters, and when we add the numbers of these four chapters, plus the numbers of the verses where the word Wahdahu occurs, the total comes to 361, or 19x19.  The crucial first commandment of the Koran is represented by the word <u>ONE</u> when referring to God. This occurs in the Koran precisely 19 times.

\* The grand total of the numbers of all the chapters and verses where the key words ONE (Waahed) and ALONE (Wahdahu) occur is 1425, or 19x75.
The Koran teaches that Islam is built on five basic pillars:

(i) Testifying that God is ONE;
(ii) observing the contact prayers (Salat) five times daily;

(iii) fasting during Ramadan: (iv) Zakat: and

- (v) pilgrimage to Mecca (Hajj) for those who can afford it.
- As shown above, the words of the first commandment, ONE and ALONE, conform with the code. The other essential "pillars" of Islam, i.e., prayer, fasting, charity, and pilgrimage, occur in the Koran 67, 6, 32, and 9 times, respectively. These numbers add up to a total of 114, or 19x6.
- When the numbers of chapters and verses where the word "Salat" (contact prayers) occurs are added up, the total is found to be 4674, or 19x246.
- When the numbers of chapters and verses where the word "Seyam" (fasting) occurs are added up, the total is 1387, or 19x73.
- \* When the numbers of chapters and verses where the word "Zakat" (charity) occurs are added up, the total is not a multiple of 19; it is 2395, which is higher than the multiple by only 1. But then, the equivalent total for the word "Hajj" (pilgrimage) is 645, which is lower than the multiple by 1. This means that the numbers of chapters and verses containing the words "Zakat" and "Hajj", together, add up to a multiple of 19, namely, 3040 (19x160). Since charity and pilgrimage are not obligatory on every Muslim, this mathematical pattern seems to reflect their special position among the duties proposed by the Koran.
